Directions to Hardy Murphy Coliseum:

Heading North on I-35, take EXIT 29, toward Madill/Ardmore. Merge onto US-70 E toward Madill, go 2.7 miles, Turn Left on Lake Murray Drive/OK-77S, go 2.2 miles. Hardy Murphy Coliseum will be on your right.

Heading south on I-35, take EXIT 31A toward Ardmore. Go 2.6 miles; turn right onto S Washington St/OK-77S. Continue 1.1 miles following OK-77S. Stay right at T, Hardy Murphy Coliseum will be on you left.

OFFICIAL RULES and Regulations 2016

1. **A negative Coggins certificate** or copy dated within one year of the show is required for ALL Horses & Ponies.
2. **Payment of Fees:** Only cash, check or Money Orders payable in US Currency will be accepted. Fees must be paid in full with paper work and signatures complete **before numbers will be issued.** You can include an open check with your entries or pay the day of the show. Please make checks payable to Johnson Performance Horses or JPH. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show. **Post entry fee is \$2 per class. Refund Policy:** No refunds will be given unless a class is canceled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate/Doctor's note and notification to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The Show Committee's discretion will be used in other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.
3. **Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors** shall indemnify and hold harmless Johnson Performance Horses, Hardy Murphy Coliseum, show sponsors, employees and/or all horse show officials and employees or volunteers from any and all liability resulting in injury and/or loss sustained by any person, child or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned. Be sure to sign the release of liability attached to your entry form.
4. **Ribbons:** Ribbons for 1-6th place will be given in all classes. Champion and Reserve Champion in all divisions will receive rosettes. Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion will receive a neck sash.
6. **All riders in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear.** Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. **NOTE:** Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.
7. All dogs must be on a leash or secured at all times.
8. **ANY** abuse toward any animal or Show Official/Staff will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, **WITHOUT REFUND.**
9. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Classes will be split where entries warrant. Decisions of the Show Management are final.
10. **Two (2) Minute Gate Rule:** To be strictly enforced. Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for requested tack change. The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes
12. **RV Parking** is available. Fee is \$25 nightly with hookups.
13. There will be a concession stand on the grounds.

Arbuckle Celebration Open classes

1. Open to horses and ponies of any breed and need not be registered.
2. Amateur Definition: An adult of 18 years old (January 1st) that has not engaged in any of the following activities which would make him/her a professional in the horse industry.
 - a. Accepts remuneration for riding, driving, showing, training, schooling, or conducting clinics or seminars.
 - b. Accepts remuneration for giving riding or driving lessons, lessons in showmanship, instructions in equitation or horse training.
 - c. Advertises professional services such as training or giving lessons by way of business cards, print ads, or internet.

ARBUCKLE CELEBRATION OPEN CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Open Costume Liberty

To be judged on imagination and creativity of the presentation and with consideration of the horse's expression and movement. Music should be in the theme of the costume. All adornments should be secure and deemed safe for horse and handlers. The exhibitor and helper enter the arena with the horse. At the first sound of music, the horse is turned loose. The music should be time to exactly one and a half minutes (1 1/2). Once the music stops, the exhibitor has exactly two (2) minutes to catch the horse. Exhibitors may show individually or with the aid of one helper. Youth exhibitors may not present a stallion.

Open Costume

Class is to be judged on creativity, dramatic and or humorous value, authenticity to period, suitability of costume to horse and handler and manners. Exhibitors may show individually or as a group. Horse may be ridden or lead. It will be at the Judge's discretion to decide if a costume is unsafe or creates an unsafe atmosphere in which case it will be cause for elimination.

Open Hunter

Over Fences (O/F): To be shown over a course of a minimum of six fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement, and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Handy Classes are judged 100% on performance. Fence Heights to be designated by rider starting at 18"

Under Saddle (U/S): To be eligible, animal must have shown in and completed an over fences (o/f) class. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. May be required to hand gallop one way of the ring but no more than eight animals at one time.

Green Horse Western Pleasure

To show both ways of the ring and the walk and jog. Open to horse in their 1st year of showing under saddle. Year starts January 1st. May not enter in any other class at this show where the lope is required. Judged on manners, quality of gate and suitability as a pleasure horse.

Western Pleasure

Open to all riders, horses to be shown at a walk, jog and lope(walk/jog division not to lope) both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein, without undue restraint. To be judged 65% on performance with emphasis on manners; 25% on conformation and movement; 10% on appointments. No martingales, tiedowns or cavesons allowed. May use 2 hands with a snaffle or hackamore on any age horse. Any curb bit with a curb strap or curb chain must be ridden with one hand. Proper Western tack and attire required.

Western Horsemanship

Open to all rider to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal and rider and suitability of animal to rider. Tests or pattern may be required and will be posted 1 hour before class.

English Pleasure

Open all riders riders, horse to be shown at a walk, trot and canter(walk/trot division not to canter) both ways of the ring, with light contact, without undue restraint. To be judged 65% performance with emphasis on manners; 25% conformation and movement; 10% appointments. No martingales, tiedowns or cavesons allowed. Proper english tack and attire required.

English Equitation

Open to all riders to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal & rider and suitability of animal to rider. Tests or pattern may be required and will be posted 1 hour before class.

Pet Pony Obstacle

Open to all horses and ponies for children age 8 and under. Age as of January 1st of this year. To be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot by handlers. To be judged 100% on performance and manners.

In-Hand Trail

Open to all horses and handlers, to be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot. To be judged 100% on performance.

Trail

Open to all horses and riders, English or Western equipment. To be shown over and through obstacles at a walk, optional trot or jog and optional canter or lope. To be judged 100% on performance.

Ranch Riding

Open to all horses and riders to be shown individually. Pattern will be posted at least 1 hour before class. Refer to AQHA rules for this class.
